Public Parking Lot Reconfiguration

January 3, 2018

Public Parking Lot at the base of Spring Street.

This correspondence provides an update for the reconfiguration of the Public Parking Lot.

Work Activities: Start Date/Work Activities – Phase 3

Impact to Adjacencies:

- Construction for the reconfiguration of the public parking lot at the base of Spring Street will begin to enter the third stage of construction, starting January 15. Since this day is a holiday for some, it was specifically selected with the hopes of having the least amount of impact transitioning from one parking area to the other on this day. A police detail will be onsite for both January 15 and 16 to help direct traffic to the new parking area. Additional signage will also be installed.
- The existing parking spaces will be relocated further west to the area that construction is currently occurring. The entrance/exit will now be along Walden Street only. The “10 minute” parking spaces along Spring Street (outside of B&L) will remain for now. We are exploring options to keep handicap parking in its current location.
- Noise/disturbances associated with construction (back up alarms, ledge removal, excavations, dust, mud and trucks) should be expected.
- Further circulation of this document will be greatly appreciated.
- Thank you in advance for your patience while some of your daily activities are going to be disrupted for the foreseeable future.
