Rebuild

This correspondence provides a status update for the upcoming project of rebuilding the retaining wall and stairs between Currier and Fitch in Berkshire Quad

Dates for Activity: October 8 – April 30, 2019

Work Activities: Removal and replacement of the brick walls and stairs between Currier and Fitch residence Halls.

Impact to Adjacencies:

- Construction Fence will go up this week on both side of the project site to protect pedestrians and maintain a secure project site.
- Work is expected to commence by Wednesday, October 10.
- Pedestrian travel East-West between Currier and Fitch will not be allowed for the duration of the project.
- Work Hours will be M-F 8am-5pm.
- Demolition of the existing masonry will require the use of loud saws, jackhammers, excavators and a ram-hoe. This initial task, lasting approximately 1 week, will be noisy at times. Such loud work will not begin prior to 9am.
- Essential construction vehicles will require access to the quad and will drive in via the NW corner near East College.
- The project will be in progress until late November and then work will stop until spring 2019 arrives for completion of final details.
